V. Kaleidoscope — Educational Programme

Screening for Children with Disabilities — IME Anne-Marie Raillon

The first Kaleidoscope edition was dedicated to children and teenagers with disabilities from IME Anne-Marie Raillon. A projection and storytelling session were offered, animated by actress Anne Arovas. The programme established the festival's commitment to inclusive access to culture from its very first edition.

Weekly Storytelling Sessions — from November 2010

From November 2010, the Centre d'Animation Maurice Ravel and Association Talulah launched a weekly Wednesday afternoon storytelling programme for children — ecological and traditional fairy tales. Sessions were also offered to sick children at Hôpital Saint-Maurice during the first quarter of 2011.

VI. Other Activities

2008 — Photo Competition

Association Talulah organised a photo competition on the theme 'an atypical, unusual or strange urban and/or natural landscape.' The five winners received concert tickets for the group Moriarty.

22 October 2009 — Art Coffee / Contes et Légendes

A storytelling evening organised in partnership with Centre d'Animation Daviel — fairy tales and legends exploring the marvellous.

14 December 2009 — First Short Film Evening

A dedicated short film screening was organised at Cinéma l'Archipel for cinema and audiovisual professionals. Following the screening, a cocktail reception allowed guests to meet the directors.

9 April 2010 — Art'Coffee / Découverte des Éco-Métiers

In partnership with Centre d'Animation Daviel, the association organised a professional evening on eco-careers — in the presence of professionals from ADEME and the French Ministry of Sustainable Development. The evening's theme: 'Eco-careers: what are they, who are they for, how do they work, what is the reality?'

27–28 November 2010 — Art 2 Jours Festival

Association Talulah participated in the Art 2 Jours cultural event (Centre d'Animation Maurice Ravel), organising two storytelling sessions for children.
